

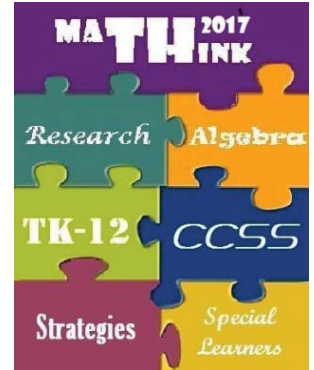


MaTHink 2017 Mini Conference

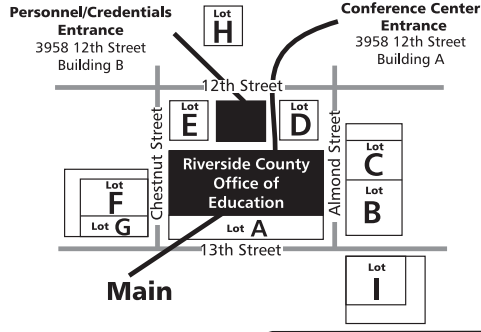
