

## The Landscape of Learning for Fractions (Grades 4-8)

In this two-day session, Cathy Fosnot will focus on ways teachers can support students in learning about fractions. The Standards for Mathematical Practice described in the California Standards require that students make sense of problems and persevere in solving them, craft viable arguments and critique the reasoning of others, and choose appropriate tools for modeling and mathematizing situations. How do we ensure that we are helping our students to meet the standards?

- Learn how to use realistic contexts to support the development of fractions.
- Construct a landscape of learning comprised of the big ideas, strategies, and models for fractions, decimals, and percents aligned with the California Standards.
- Learn how to support efficient computation, sense-making and problem solving.
- Explore mini-lessons crafted with strings of related problems designed to support
  a repertoire of mental math strategies for operations with fractions, decimals, and
  percents.
- Help students feel like "real mathematicians" at work.
- Analyze the use of various models as tools for representation.

Each participant will receive a book from Cathy Fosnot's series on Fractions, Decimals, and Percents.
